Senator Hesselbein and Representative Joers to Hold Joint Listening Session on State Budget Wisconsin Minority Leader Joins with Assembly Colleague for Sessions in Middleton, Mazomanie and Waunakee

State Senator Dianne Hesselbein (D-Middleton) and State Representative Alex Joers (D-Middleton) will host three listening sessions on the State Budget on Saturday, May 3: In Middleton from 10:30 a.m. - 11:30 a.m. at the Middleton Public Library, 7425 Hubbard Avenue; in Mazomanie from 12:00 noon – 1:00 p.m. at the Mazomanie Community Building, 9 Brodhead Street; and in Waunakee from 1:30 p.m. – 2:30 p.m. at the Waunakee Village Center, 333 S. Madison Street.

"Budgets are about values and priorities," Senator Hesselbein said. "Governor Evers' proposal supports our public schools, lowers costs for Wisconsin families, ensures access to affordable child care, invests in our farmers, protects our environment, and improves our roads. With the chaos at the Federal level, it is more important than ever to hear from the people I serve about what is most important to them and the concerns they have."

"This is a critical time in Wisconsin as we determine what we will fund and how we will fund it over the next two years," said Representative Joers. "These listening sessions are an essential opportunity for us as legislators to share information and to get a first-hand understanding of what our constituents care most about."
