Senator Bradley Invites Media to Opening Hearing of Study Committee on AI

Committee's First Hearing to feature roundtable discussion exploring AI's impact on workforce issues

On Wednesday, July 24th, the Legislative Council Study Committee on the Regulation of Artificial Intelligence (AI) will hold its inaugural hearing in the Richard T. Anderson Center at Waukesha County Technical College. During the hearing, which will begin at 9 A.M., committee members will hear a presentation from Matthew Friedel, a Senior Lecturer at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee (UWM) and a co-Founder of both the UWM Disruptive Technologies Lab and Milwaukee Venture Partners. Following the presentation, committee members will engage in a roundtable discussion about AI's impact on workforce issues.
