## **Righting Governor Evers' Wrongs**

Madison, WI – Senator Cory Tomczyk (R-Mosinee) issued the following statement on yesterday's floor session:

"Governor Evers' rampant use of vetoes has prevented Wisconsin families from getting the relief they desperately need from out of control inflation. The special session yesterday has shown that Republicans remain dedicated to meaningful workforce development and substantial tax relief. We voted to restore the \$2 billon middle-class tax cut that the Governor vetoed earlier this year. We are tackling child care costs and expanding child tax credits.

Governor Evers has done nothing but block and obstruct the Legislature from passing common sense legislation and putting money back into the pockets of taxpayers. Governor Evers needs to stop fighting against, and start fighting for, Wisconsin.

During the floor session yesterday, we also passed three bills that I authored; SB 324, SB 355, and SB 436. SB 324 codifies federal law by prohibiting local and state governmental units from imposing restrictions on refrigerants that are designated acceptable for use by the EPA. SB 355 will allow green warning lights on public utility, telecommunications, or cooperative vehicles to ensure their safety on the roadway. SB 436 will remove the bureaucratic red tape and the need for a work permit for a minor who is 14 or 15 in order for them to obtain a job."
