Tentative Agreement on Final Shared Revenue Bill

Madison, **WI** —Senator Eric Wimberger (R – Green Bay) issued the following statement Thursday after the Legislature unveiled changes to the shared revenue proposal that would dramatically increase funding sent to municipalities, invest a historic amount in education, and repeal the private property tax:

"This legislation fixes disparities caused by the old shared revenue formula. It will ensure every Wisconsin municipality, both large and small, has the resources to fund critical services including police, fire and EMS.

"Additionally, through a historic investment of more than \$1 billion in our public schools and \$280 million in our choice/charter schools, this bill will help provide our students with the high-quality education they deserve. It is the largest investment in education in Wisconsin's history"
