## 2024 Senate Scholar Program Application Open Through Nov. 17th

**Madison, WI** – Senator Brad Pfaff (D-Onalaska) and the Wisconsin State Senate are now accepting applications for the 2024 Senate Scholar Program. The Senate Scholar Program is an elite program designed to challenge Wisconsin's best students aged 16-18. One student from each of the 33 Senate Districts may participate in the week-long program in Madison.

Senate Scholars engage in a variety of experiences during their stay in the program. Typical activities may include attending floor debates in the Senate Chamber, committee hearings, and seminars conducted by individuals involved in the legislative process such as lobbyists, reporters, legislative staff, Governor's staff and Supreme Court Justices.

In addition, Senate Scholars will be required to engage in mock legislative activities, such as bill and amendment drafting, policy analysis, fiscal analysis, constituent communications and lobbying. These activities will culminate in a mock legislative hearing at which Senate Scholars will provide testimony and then hold an executive session to vote a bill out of committee.
