Sen. Pfaff Celebrates Earth Day in Monroe County

(Sparta, WI) – To commemorate Earth Day, Senator Brad Pfaff (D-Onalaska) joined the Monroe County Conservation Department for a tour to learn about the collaboration between landowners and farmers on community-led land and water stewardship efforts.

The tour featured visits to property buyouts in the 100-year floodplain, a stream restoration and monitoring station, and the Klinkner Farm. Each stop focused on different conservation practices taking place in the area.

Commenting on the tour, Senator Pfaff said, “It was great to see firsthand the stream restoration and farmland preservation work being accomplished. Strong community-led stewardship efforts like these will keep our region a sustainable, productive, and scenic place for years to come.”
