Conservation bill passes in the Senate

(Madison, WI)— State Senator Brad Pfaff (D-Onalaska) is pleased to announce passage of legislation that expands the well compensation grant program, invests in producer-led watersheds, and modifies the allocation for county conservation grants.

After the vote, Sen. Pfaff said, "We can always do more to promote good land and water stewardship here in Wisconsin. So I was proud to co-sponsor and vote for this bipartisan bill that will help farmers implement strategies to keep nutrients in the soil, replace contaminated wells, and prevent pollutant runoff."

"We're investing in the health and wellness of rural communities. My hope is that we can continue working across the aisle towards common-sense solutions to our state's generational problems."

SB-678 passed the Senate on a voice vote. The action was messaged to the Assembly for consideration. The bill text can be viewed here.
