Legislators Introduce "Buy American" Package

Sens. Pfaff, Wirch and Reps. McGuire, Snodgrass, Doyle proudly supporting American job creation

MADISON – Today, Wisconsin legislators, led by Senator Brad Pfaff and Representative Tip McGuire, introduced legislation to ensure that the State of Wisconsin purchases goods that are made in America and in our state.

- LRB-5501/1, the **Buy American Act**, requires that the State of Wisconsin purchase goods that are to the greatest extent possible made in the United States.
- LRB-5502/1 amends Wisconsin's state constitution, which currently requires that stationary purchases be awarded to the lowest bidder. This legislation requires that Wisconsin purchase from the lowest bidder operating in the state, unless no Wisconsin-based companies bid.

"When we support American companies, we make a statement that we recognize the value of American manufacturing, both for the health of our local economies and workers, but also to reduce our reliance on overseas companies and supply chains that can fail or become overburdened," said **Rep. Tip McGuire**, "I am proud to support this legislation that ensures the purchases that the state is already making can strengthen our supply chains and our economy here at home."

"Wisconsin-made products are some of the best in the world," said **Senate lead author Brad Pfaff**, "This legislation will make sure our state government prioritizes products made here at home, strengthening Wisconsin workers, businesses, communities, and our supply chain."
