Senator Pfaff and Governor Evers Visit Couleecap Housing Development and Food Pantry in Prairie du Chien

Madison, WI – Today, State Senator Brad Pfaff (D-Onalaska) and Governor Tony Evers visited Couleecap's Brunson Street Housing Development and Couleecap's Food Pantry and Bargain Boutique in Prairie du Chien. The Brunson Street Housing Development is a four-home, affordable workforce housing development, which has been developed in partnership with the city of Prairie du Chien and Couleecap Inc., along with grant funding from the Wisconsin Department of Administration.

Following the visit, Senator Pfaff said,

"Housing is a bridge to a higher quality of life. Increasing access to affordable housing is essential for employment, economic growth, and building a stronger community."

"The Brunson Street Housing Development, alongside existing resources like Couleecap's Food Pantry and Bargain Boutique, will give our neighbors the tools to succeed and enhance the Prairie du Chien community as a whole."
