## Senator Pfaff Statement on 51st Anniversary of Roe v. Wade

**Madison, WI** – Today is the 51<sup>st</sup> anniversary of the Roe v. Wade decision by the United States Supreme Court, which recognized a woman's constitutional right to make reproductive health care decisions without government involvement. State Senator Brad Pfaff (D-Onalaska) released the following statement on the anniversary:

"The recent attacks on reproductive freedoms in Wisconsin and across our country are unacceptable. Decisions on reproductive health care are deeply personal and should be made by individuals and their families without government interference."

"I will continue to fight like hell to make sure reproductive freedoms in Wisconsin are fully protected. We must codify Roe v. Wade into law and protect this fundamental right."
