**Senator Pfaff Applauds Investment in Local Roads**

**Madison, WI** – Today, Governor Evers announced nearly \$150 million in state funding for local road improvement projects. State Senator Brad Pfaff (D-Onalaska) voted in support of this funding in the bipartisan 2021-23 biennial budget. This investment includes funding for road projects in towns, municipalities, and counties across the 32<sup>nd</sup> State Senate District. After the announcement, Sen. Pfaff released the following statement:

**”I’m proud to have voted for this funding in the state budget to improve our local roads. This investment in transportation infrastructure creates jobs, connects our communities, and fosters economic growth.”**
