**Senator Pfaff Supports Additional Resources for EMS Providers**

**Madison, WI** – Today, State Senator Brad Pfaff (D – Onalaska) joined with Representative Steve Doyle (D – Onalaska) and Representative Jill Billings (D – La Crosse) to highlight that EMS providers throughout Wisconsin will be receiving nearly \$32 million in EMS Flex Grants, including over \$2 million in the 32<sup>nd</sup> Senate District. This funding will support EMS providers as they meet the needs of their communities and continue their critical, life-saving work. State Senator Brad Pfaff (D – Onalaska) provided the following statement with the announcement of this funding:

“EMS providers throughout western Wisconsin help keep our communities safe and provide life-saving care to citizens in need. This funding will be an important resource as first responders throughout our area continue their life-saving work.
