Senator Kapenga to Serve as Chair of Senate Committee on Public Benefit & Regulatory Reform

Madison, WI – On Thursday, Senate Majority Leader Scott Fitzgerald named Senator Chris Kapenga (R-Delafield) chairman of the newly formed Senate Committee on Public Benefit and Regulatory Reform, and also appointed him to two other standing committees.

“I look forward to serving as the chairman of the Senate Committee on Public Benefit and Regulatory Reform and working with my colleagues to find solutions to reform our public assistance programs and improve our regulatory environment,” said Kapenga. “This starts with developing innovative reforms that put individuals on the path to self-sufficiency and give them purpose from a paycheck.
