## **Senator Stroebel Sworn-in to Second Term**

Outlines legislative priorities, committee membership

Madison, WI – Today, Senator Duey Stroebel (R-Cedarburg) was sworn-in to his second term to the State Senate representing the 20<sup>th</sup> District. This session Stroebel will chair the Committee on Government Operations, Technology & Consumer Protection. Stroebel will serve as the vice-chairman of the Committee on Financial Institution, Constitution & Federalism, and a member of Judiciary & Public Safety, and the Joint Committee for Review of Administrative Rules.

Senator Stroebel issued the following statement:
