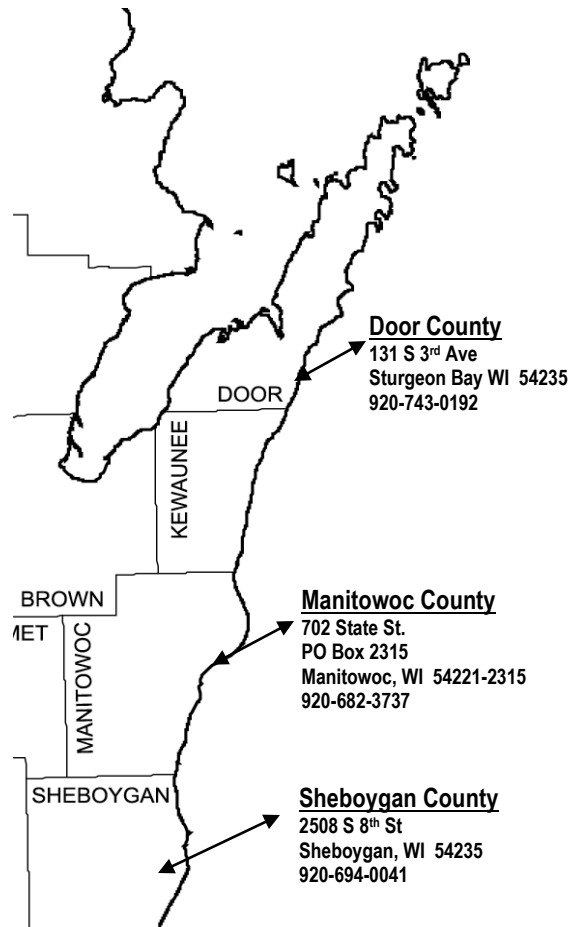

## **Housing**

*Are you considering a home purchase but don't know where to start? Do you have special needs and desire a place to rent?*

### **Home Buyer Program (M/D)**

Assists eligible households with direct loans for down payment, closing costs and acquisition

### **Home Buyer Education (M/S/D/K)**

Helps ensure that buyers understand the home purchase process through counseling and education

### **Rental Housing (M/S/D)**

Lakeshore CAP has Elderly/Disabled housing available for those who qualify

## **Food**

*Having trouble locating a secure source of food for your family?*

### **Food Pantry & Emergency Food Assistance (M/S/D/K+)**

We can provide you with pantry information for Manitowoc, Calumet, Door, Kewaunee, Outagamie, Ozaukee, Sheboygan, Washington and Waupaca counties.

We are one of the 16 Emergency Feeding Organizations in the state of Wisconsin.

## **Family**

*For questions about parenting, community resources, or help for teen parents, Lakeshore Family Resources offers:*

### **Parenting Classes (M)**

For parents & caregivers of children from prenatal to 6 years old. We also offer classes for parents with AODA or mental health issues.

### **Connections Count (M)**

Support for parents & caregivers of children ages 0-5 in finding community resources, services, support and opportunities that address the family's identified needs and goals.

### **Community Response (M/S)**

Program for families who need extra support in caring for their children (must be referred through Human Services).

### **Teen Parenting (M)**

School-based support for pregnant or parenting teens.

### **Investing Early Initiative (M)**

Welcome Baby packets for new parents and Community Developmental Screening events for children 5 and under

## **Youth**

*Do you have concerns about ensuring children a safe environment to grow or about teaching youth how to be accountable?*

### **Court Appointed Special Advocates (M)**

Volunteer-based program which recruits, screens and trains citizens to be the voice of abused children in court, advocating for a safe, permanent home.

### **Juvenile Restitution (D)**

Rehabilitative program serving offenders between the ages of 10 and 17, holding youth accountable, providing restitution to victims of crime and building good work habits.

### **Student Success Advocate (M)**

Provides support to families with young school age children, working to develop relationships between school and family to reduce truancy.

### **Manitowoc Youth Diversion Program (M)**

Otherwise known as Teen Court, a meaningful alternative to the juvenile justice system that provides accountability and community engagement for first-time offending youth.

## **Community**

*Are you homeless, at risk of becoming homeless, or looking for information on low-cost housing?*

### **Rapid Re-Housing (M/S/D/K)**

Assists qualifying homeless individuals and families to secure and maintain stable housing through financial assistance and case management services.

### **Homeless Prevention (M/S/D/K)**

Helps qualifying individuals and families who are at risk of becoming homeless to obtain or maintain housing. Community referrals and case management provided.

### **Tenant Based Rental Assistance (M/S/D/K)**

Assists qualifying people who are literally homeless or at immediate risk of becoming homeless, with preference for someone with a disability.

## **Jobs & Economic Development**

*Are you looking for affordable resources to start your own business? Would you like to improve your earning potential and career prospects?*

### **Skills Enhancement Program (M/S/D/K/C)**

Provides opportunities to explore career options and increase earning potential. We offer financial assistance for tuition, books, travel and child care to eligible individuals.

### **GED/HSED Program (M/S/D/K/C)**

Provides opportunity to return to school and earn your GED or HSED diploma. We offer financial assistance towards tuition, books and travel expenses.
