

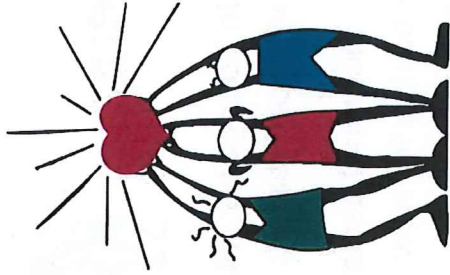
Our Mission

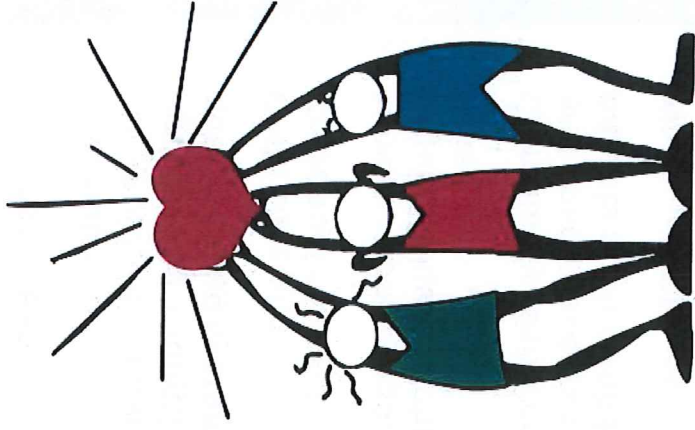
