Frequently Asked Questions

❖ What is a Community Response Program?

A Community Response Program is a service designed to strengthen and support families. Each family defines what they need. This program is completely voluntary and is offered by Northwest Connection Family Resources.

❖ What will this do for my family?

Your needs will determine what services will be offered to you. You are in control of what happens. Program staff will partner with you and your family, if you choose to volunteer for the program. Services are designed to meet the needs of your family.

❖ Will anyone be notified that my family is a part of the Community Response Program?

No. Any contact with the Community Response Program is completely confidential. If you choose to release information to an outside source a release form would need to be signed.

❖ How much does it cost?

All services are offered to you and your family at no charge. Services may be provided in your home, location of your choice, or Northwest Connection Family Resources. Mileage reimbursement may be available to you.

❖ How long does this program last?

This is completely up to you. Sometimes just having the opportunity to talk over a situation is helpful and all that is needed. However, your needs may be more complex and take a longer time of involvement before you feel that your goals have been met.
