

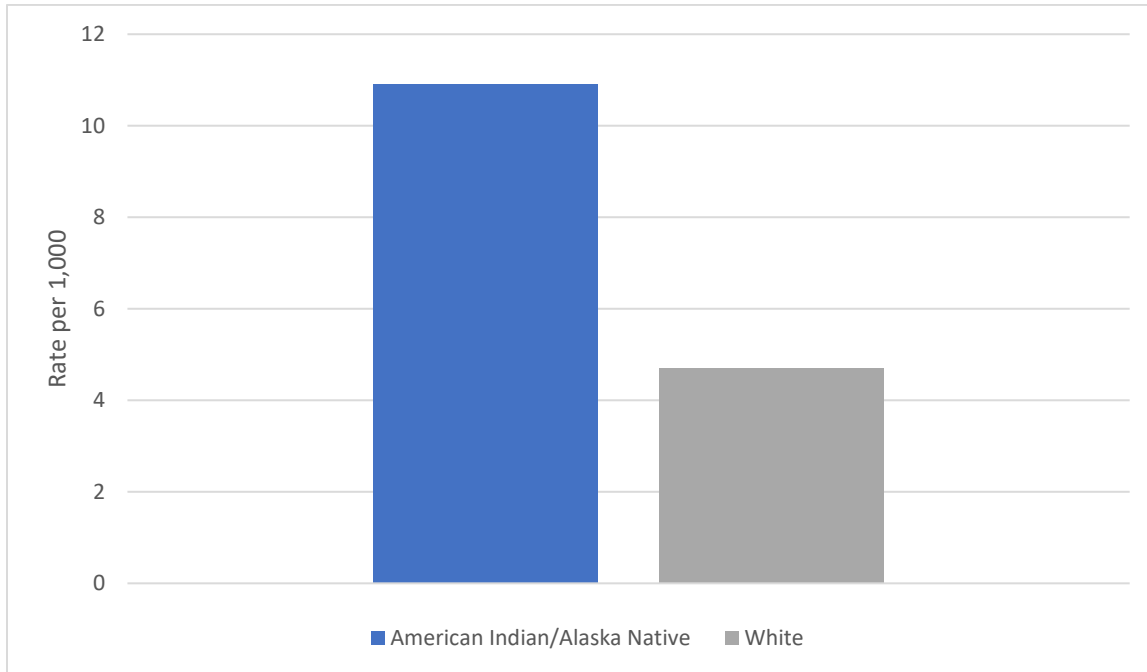

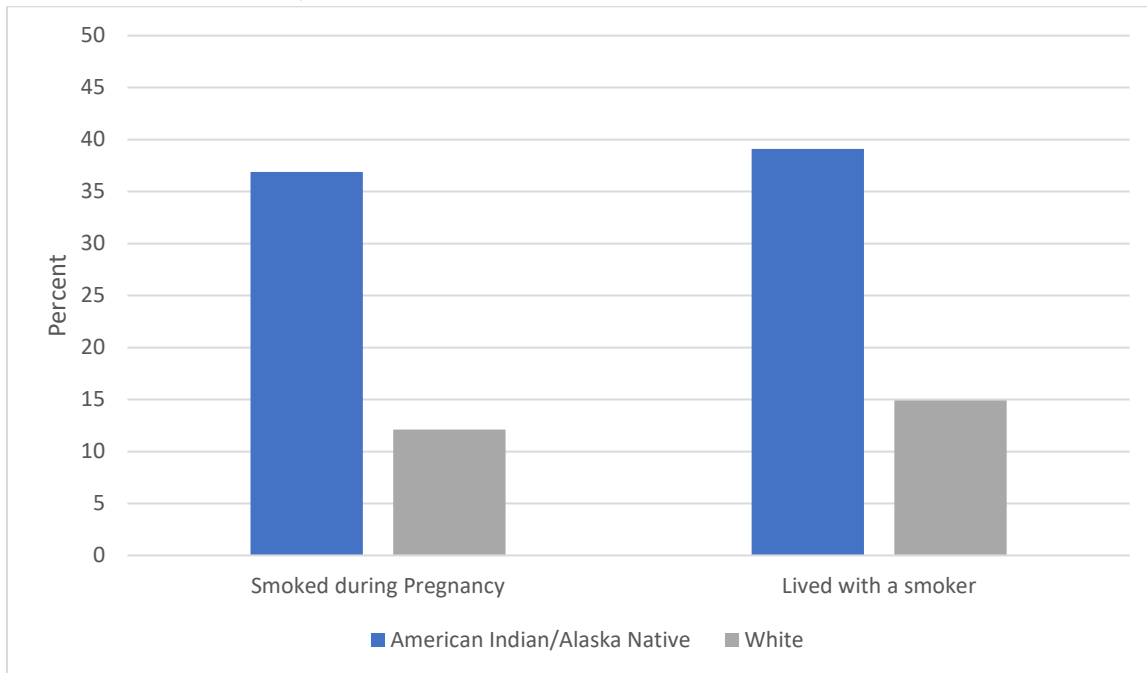

Infant mortality rates, American Indian/Alaska Natives and Whites in Wisconsin, 2014-2018



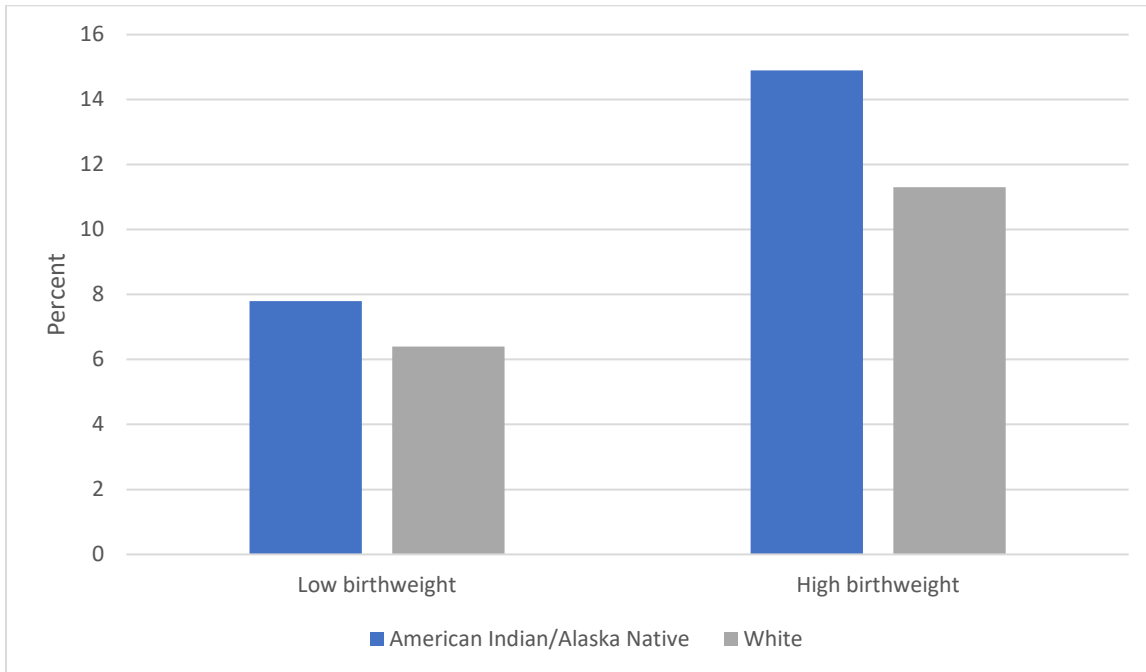

Smoking during pregnancy and living with a smoker during pregnancy, American Indian/Alaska Natives and Whites in Wisconsin, 2014-2018



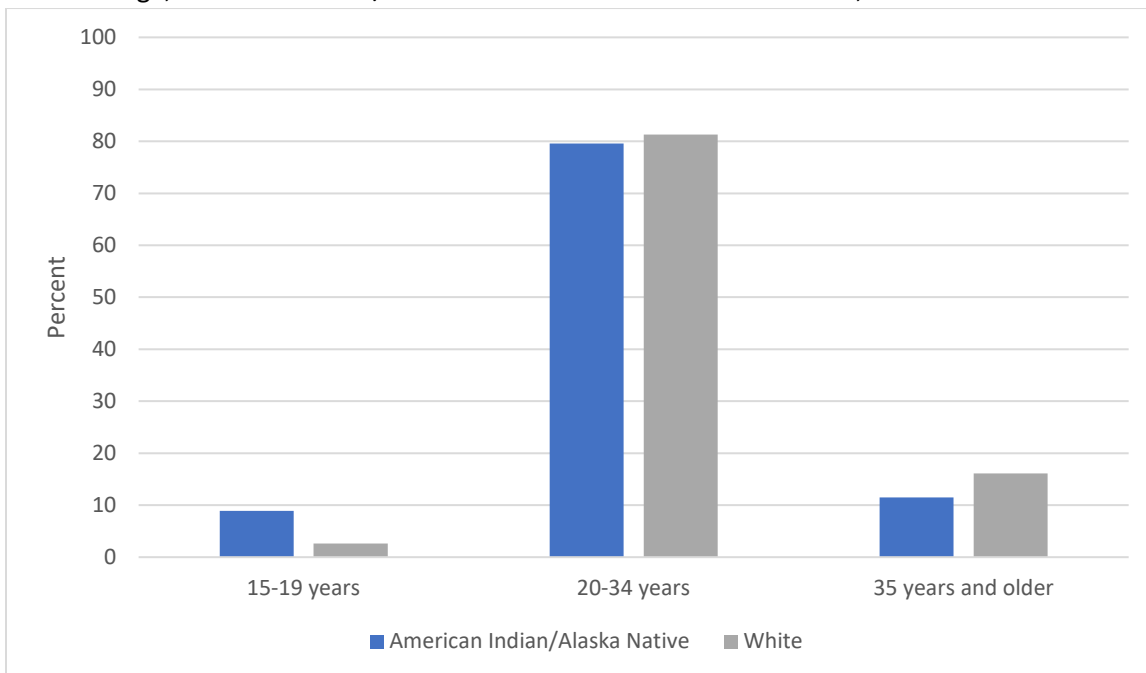

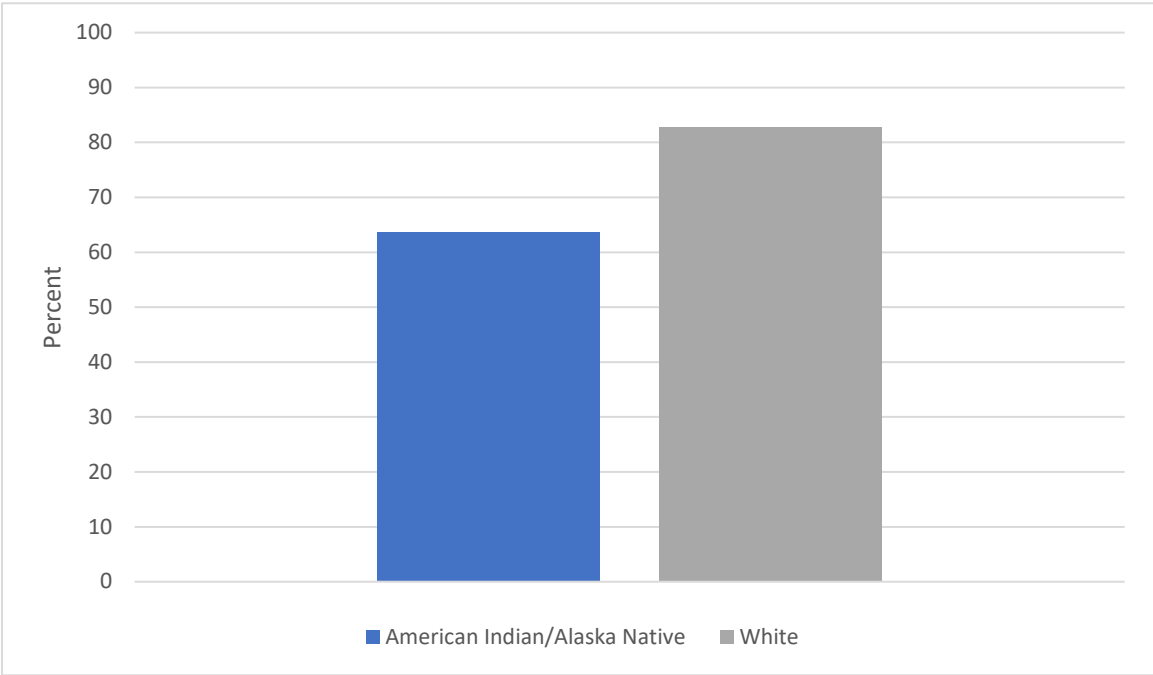

Maternal age, American Indian/Alaska Natives and Whites in Wisconsin, 2014-2018



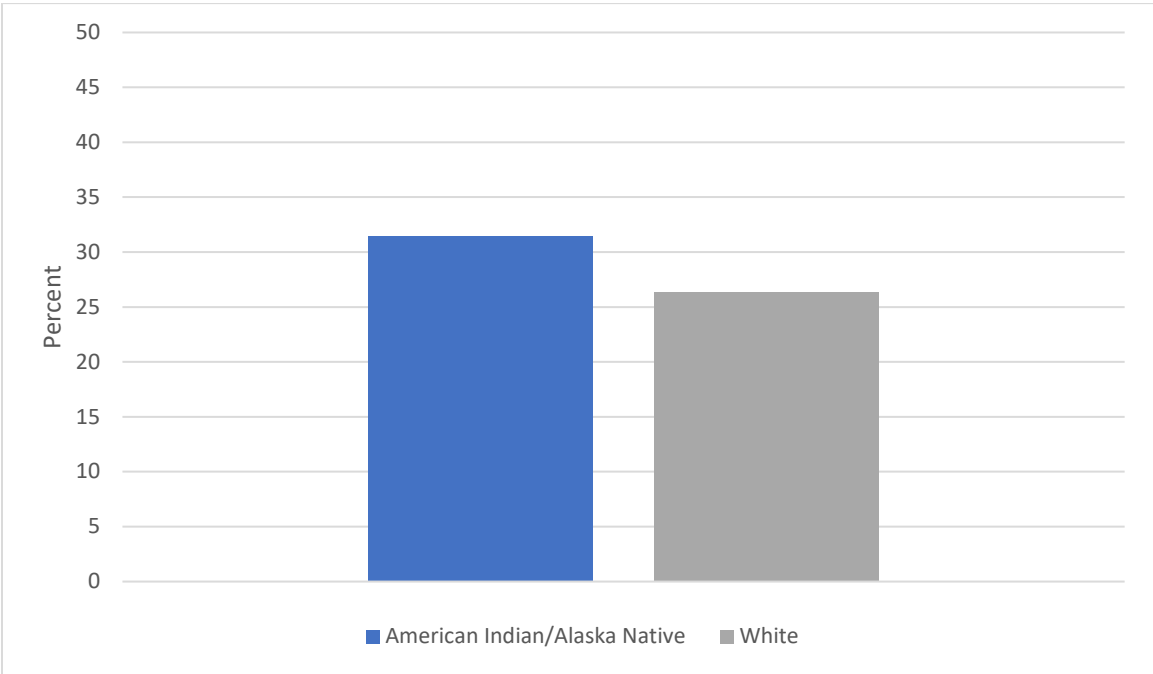

Percent of women receiving prenatal care in first trimester, American Indian/Alaska Natives and Whites in Wisconsin, 2014-2018



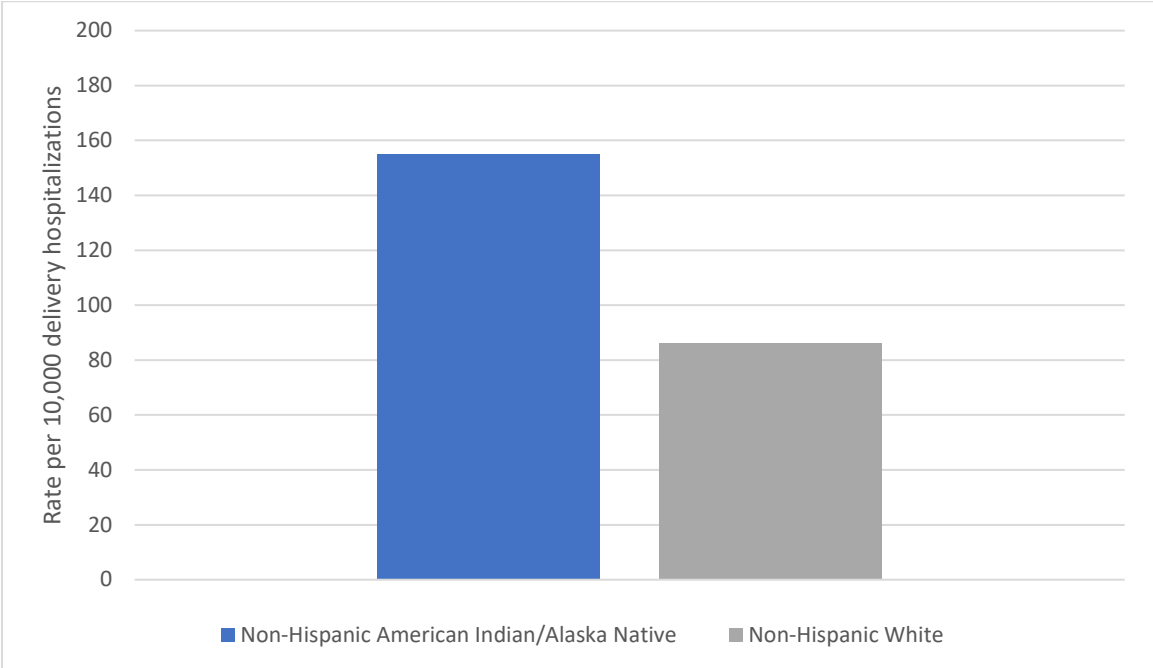
