Voucher Impact Increases Tax Levy

The day after the state aid certification came out. new revenue limit worksheet was released. In the new worksheet, the voucher impact was inputted on line 10H. This was a number that was 1) nearly impossible to predict and 2) had a direct impact on the levy For HUHS, this was a \$.03 increase the levy because of our 9 residents who attend private schools on a voucher. It increased our tax liability by roughly \$100,000.

Now, our mill rate would jump to \$3.95, negating the idea of using the EE as stabilizing the tax levvy.



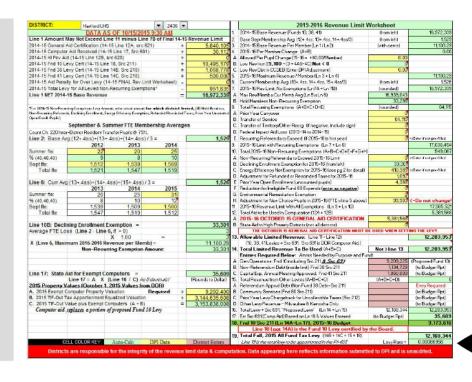

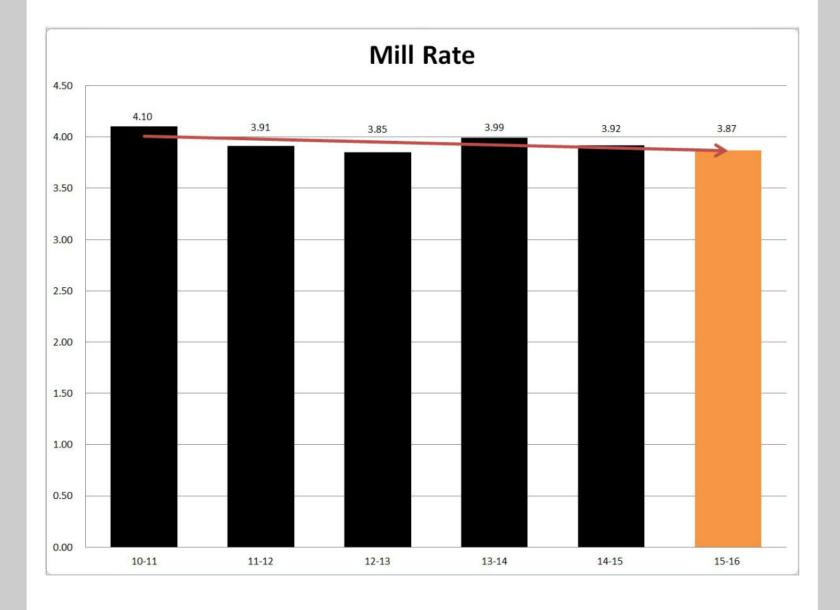

- Proposal 15-2190 Approval of Act 32 Levy as part of the repayment from the 2014-15 energy exemption projects
- Proposal 15-2191
 - Approve the overall expenditures detailed in the DPI approved format
 - Periodic budget adjustments throughout the year or in June
 - Approve the levy into each Fund as detailed in the revenue limit worksheet
 - Set the levy at \$12,168,344 which comes out to an average of \$3.87 across the municipalities
- Once established, I will report the results to DPI and create the forms that must be signed by the Board Clerk (Bill) and notarized. These can then be delivered or mailed to the appropriate municipalities
