



PRELIMINARY DRAFT - NOT READY FOR INTRODUCTION

1 **AN ACT relating to:** training materials for social services workers handling
2 substance abuse-related cases and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill provides \$50,000 of funding to the Department of Children and Families to develop and maintain online training resources for social services workers who deal with substance abuse-related cases.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1. Fiscal changes.**

4 (1) TRAINING MATERIALS FOR SUBSTANCE ABUSE-RELATED CASES. In the schedule
5 under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of
6 children and families under section 20.437 (1) (a) of the statutes, the dollar amount
7 for fiscal year 2018-19 is increased by \$50,000 to develop and maintain

1 Internet-accessible training materials for county social services or veteran services
2 workers on the appropriate response to cases involving substance abuse.
