Overseeing efforts is a newly-formed North Central Region Opioid Treatment Consortium, a partnership of 17 organizations from Iron, Price, Oneida, Vilas and Forest Counties and the Lac du Flambeau Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians, Forest County Potawatomi and Sokaogon Chippewa Community. Consortium members will focus on detoxification and treatment, improving quality of life for individuals addicted to opioids with a focus on women of child-bearing age.
