Boys and Girls Club

Motion:

Move to modify the Governor's proposal to allocate an additional \$100,000 annually from the federal temporary assistance for needy families (TANF) block grant for grants to the Boys and Girls Clubs of America to specify that the additional funding must be equally distributed amongst Boys and Girls Clubs in Milwaukee, Oshkosh, and Appleton to support the "Be Great: Graduate" program.

Note:

Current law provides \$1,175,000 FED TANF annually for grants to the Wisconsin Chapter of the Boys and Girls Clubs of America to fund programs that improve social, academic, and employment skills of youth. This includes up to \$75,000 each year for the Green Bay Boys and Girls Clubs for the Be Great: Graduate program, in the amount of matching funds that the program provides. The bill would allocate an additional \$100,000 TANF annually for grants to Boys and Girls clubs, and specify that up to \$100,000, in the amount of matching funds that the program provides, must be provided for the Be Great: Graduate program in Milwaukee.

The motion would modify the bill so that the additional \$100,000 funding must be equally distributed among Boys and Girls Clubs in Milwaukee, Oshkosh, and Appleton.
