

WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT -- EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING

Grant to Support the Building Occupational Skills of Success Program
[LFB Paper #690]

Motion:

Move to require DWD to provide a grant of \$200,000 in fiscal year 2017-18, from the Department's workforce training grants appropriation, to the City of Milwaukee for the purpose of supporting the Building Occupational Skills for Success (BOSS) program that is designed to provide students with the skills and tools needed to become future business owners if all of the following are satisfied:

- a. the City of Milwaukee provides equal matching funds to support the BOSS program.
- b. the City of Milwaukee agrees to make the BOSS program curriculum available, upon request, from any school board, operator of a charter school authorized under section 118.40 (2r) or (2x) of the statutes, private school, tribal school, or any nonprofit organization after the program has been implemented in Milwaukee Public Schools for one year.
- c. the City of Milwaukee agrees to submit a report to the Joint Committee on Finance that summarizes the results of the BOSS program by no later than 90 days after the program has been implemented in Milwaukee Public Schools for one year.

Note:

The motion would provide no addition funding to DWD's workforce training grants appropriation.
